- *All Sheep MUST have proper identification (Scrapie Tag or RFID Tag) and proof of Rabies Vaccination.
- * Sheep Entering the State of Maine from elsewhere must Have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) The CVI must be within 30 days prior to the show and a paper copy must be presented before penning animals on Friday August 2, 2024.

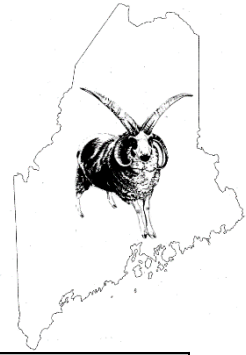

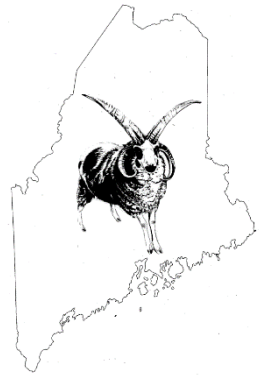
